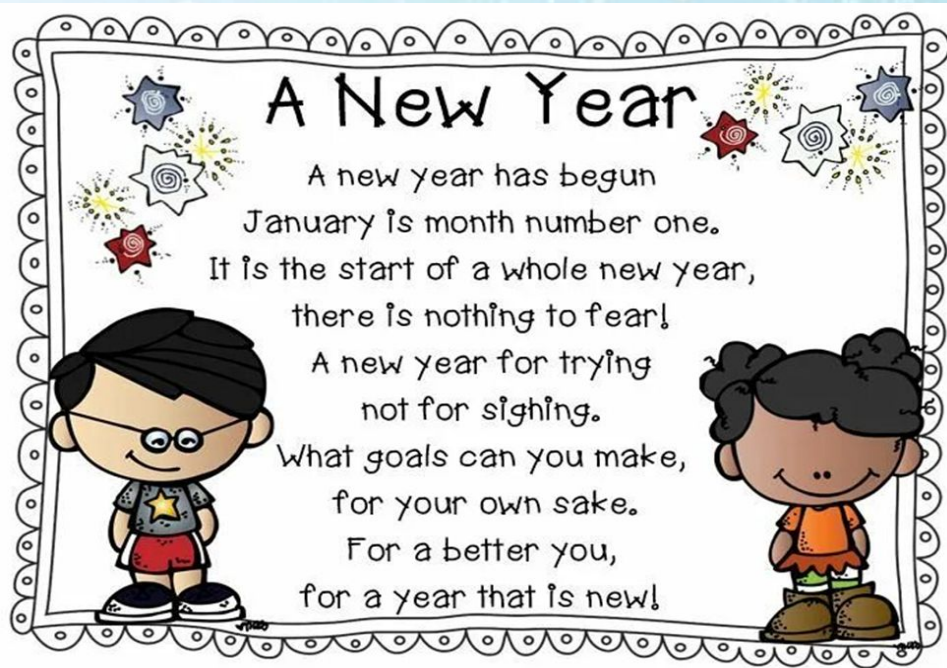

WEATHER UPDATE AND WALKING SCHOOL BUS

We will be using Environment Canada's reading at the Airport to make decisions.

Winnipeg, MB - 7 Day Forecast - Environment Canada

(all temperatures are inclusive of windchill)

- 26° and warmer: Outdoor recess, patrols, and walking school bus are all on as scheduled.
- 27° to -30° : Indoor recess and direct morning entry, shortened patrol time, walking school bus still on.
- 31° to -34°: Indoor recess, no patrols on post, walking school bus still on.
- 35° and colder: Indoor recess, no patrols on post, walking school bus cancelled for the day.

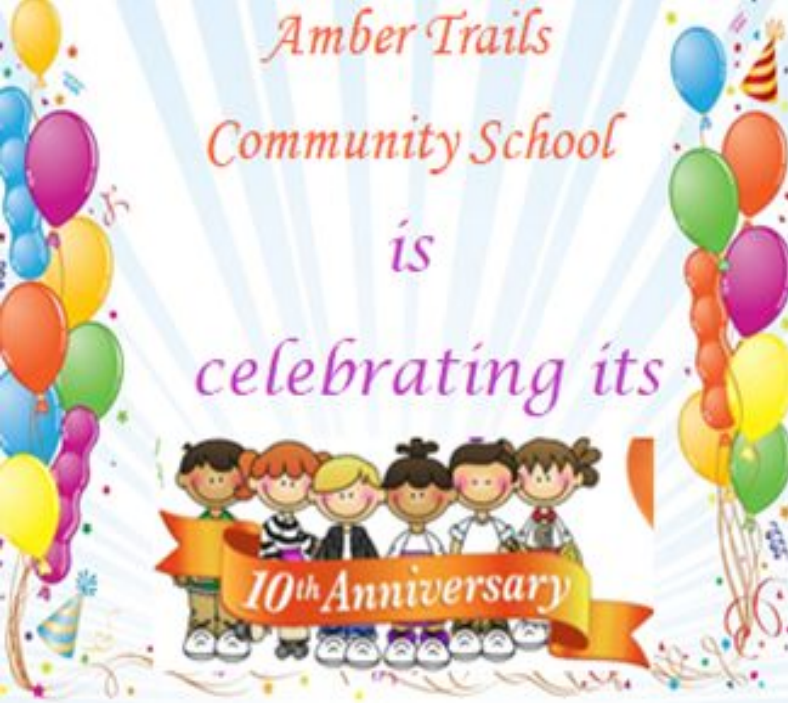
DRESS FOR THE WEATHER

We are so proud of all that you have achieved and we wish you a bright future ahead.

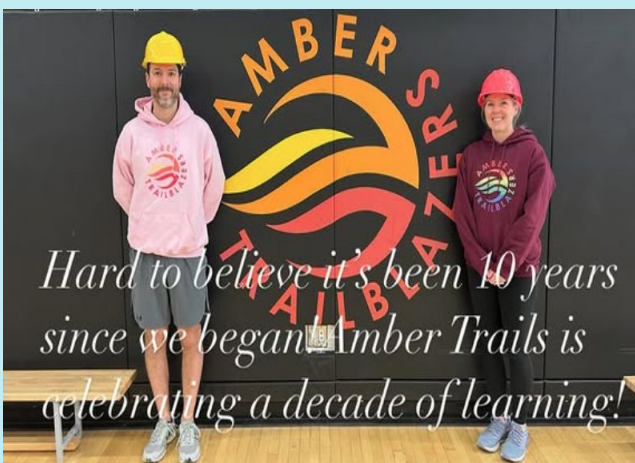

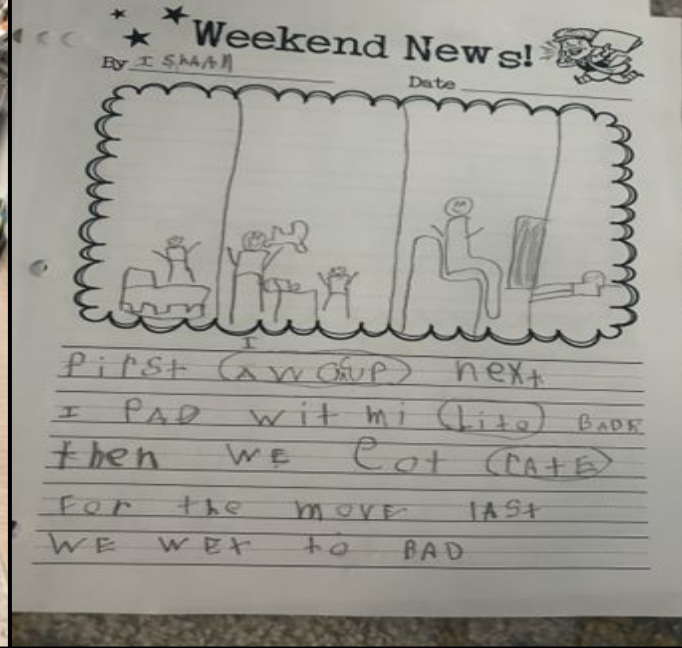
The efforts you always put in play a major role in making this school a place where learning, growth, and community thrive.

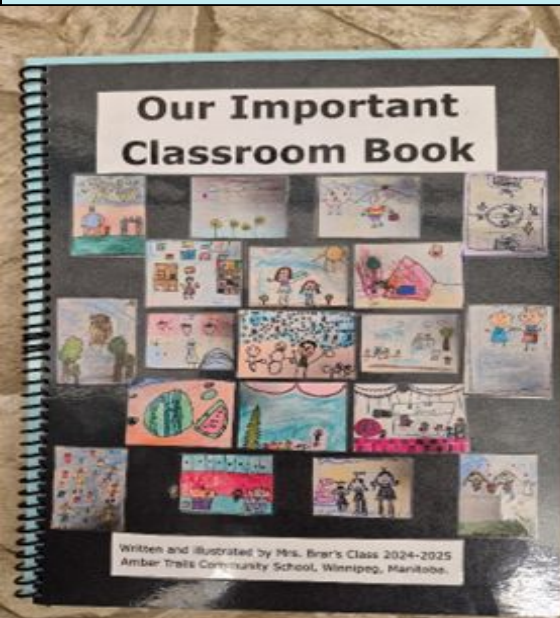
Together, we have all created something truly special, and we look forward to many more years of collaboration, learning, achievement, and shared success.

Literacy In Room 115 (Ms. Jaime) The students in Room 115 are developing their understanding of sequencing and practicing how to express events in a clear and logical order. They engage in activities such as retelling stories using transition words like *first*, *next*, *then*, and *last*. To deepen their learning, students participate in "turn and talk" discussions, sharing their own stories with peers before transferring their ideas into written form.
