






VICTORY SPOTLIGHT

This month's Victory Spotlight is from Room 17:






Room 17 students have been studying plants since the beginning of December. We started with an amaryllis, and we look forward to seeing it bloom shortly. Each day, we record our measurements of the amaryllis on a line graph to help us see how it changes over time.



We also made a collaborative mural of fictional flowers to represent each person in the class. For example, Rhiannon said about her flower (*top left*), "this flower has so many colours on it. You can feel and see all the different textures. I wanted it to have more detail so that it would have more nutrients. My flower represents kindness".

We connected our mural to the book *Just Ask* by Sonia Sotomayor. She writes, "thousands of plants bloom together, but every flower, every berry, and every leaf is different- each has a different smell, different color, different shape, and different purpose. Kids are all different, too. Each of us grows in our own way".



We are glad to see that, like each of us, the flowers on our mural are all unique. The classroom is a better place when everyone's differences are honored.

According to Liam, "if we were all the same, we would have all the same ideas. We all have special gifts to share. Share your gift with other kids".


Our January Victory Reads title is...

Compassion is complex and more meaningfully defined as an embodiment of spirit and way of being.






Self-Compassion
