"We walked on the bridge and at the end, it was beautiful!" (Delina, Room 5)


"At Brokenhead, I saw a moth and butterfly when we were walking." (Shanna, Room 5)

Our June **Victory Reads** title is **Why We Dance: A Story of Hope** by Deidre Hayrelock, illustrations by Aly McKnight.



It's a special day - the day of the Jungle Dress Dance! Before the big powwow, there's a lot to do: getting dressed, braiding hair, packing lunches, and practicing bounce-steps. But one young girl gets butterflies in her stomach thinking about performing in front of her whole community. When the drumbeats begin, though, her family soothes her nerves and reminds her why she dances. Why We Dance is a joyous celebration of a proud Indigenous tradition that inspires hope, resilience and unity.

MONTHLY MINDFULNESS

Summer break is just around the corner, and for kids that can mean having more free time. For caregivers, it can mean trying to manage screen time, while filling days with healthy, engaging activities. Consider planning daily/weekly routines and activities with your child that will make the transition into summer break easier:

- Discuss screens and electronics and agree on a reasonable amount of time per day. Make your own commitment to show your child you're doing it to.
- Involve your child in daily routines, like choosing and preparing meals and snacks.
- Decide on times of the day or week when you can do outdoor activities together.
- Schedule weekly trips to public amenities like parks, splash pads and the library.
- Make a summer calendar so that you can have a visual plan for all these summer activities and routines and have your child check them off when they're done.
