2025 Grad Updates

- Fees: Student Fees <u>must be paid in full</u> to purchase a Grad Ticket. (This includes fees for Athletics, Library, Textbooks, etc). Please call 204-339-6959 and speak to Angie Leuzinger if you have any questions about Fees.
- **Post-Secondary Registration Reimbursement:** Following payment please print the receipt and bring it into either the main office or Student Services. Seven Oaks School Division covers the cost of one post-secondary application fee, to a maximum of \$156.00. The deadline for submitting your receipt for reimbursement is June 10th, 2025.
- **Diplomas**: At Convocation students will receive their High School Diplomas printed with their legal name on them. Should they wish their preferred name printed on their diploma, please have them complete the form in the office by June 2ND. *Please Note that their official High School Transcript can only have their legal name on them.*

We would like to remind families that students should not be picked up or dropped off in the Sugar and Spice Daycare loop or the Staff Parking lot to the West of the school.


InformNET Summer Sessions open May 1ST
