# Belonging

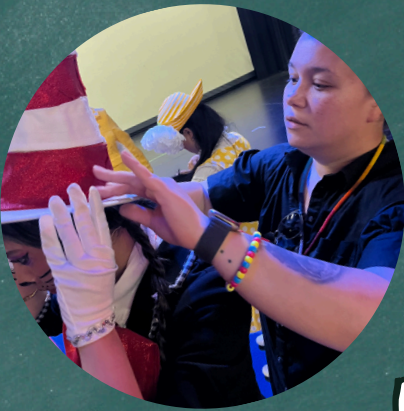

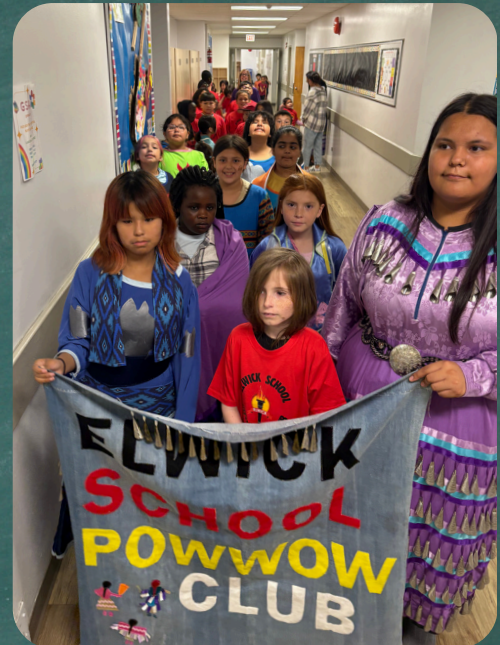

# Independence

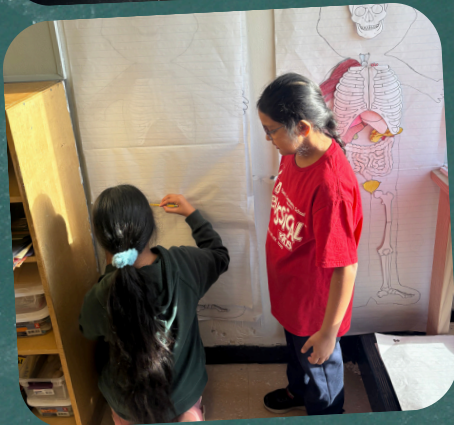
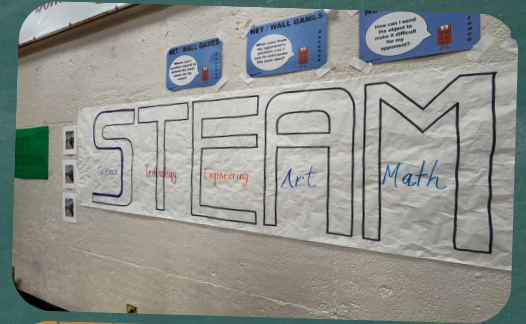
