Assuming full registration, each team will be guaranteed 5 round robin games and 1 elimination game. Morning games will begin at 8:00 am and afternoon games will begin at 12:30 pm.

We encourage teams to register in the proper level (intermediate or advanced), to ensure teams are competitive and everyone has fun. Intermediate is defined as 3.0 – 3.49. Advanced is defined as 3.5 and above.
