Sistema News



January flew by and we are gearing up for a great February at Sistema!

January 2019 held fewer performances than in months past, which has allowed us to focus in on the fundamentals. We have been working on training our ears to recognize ascending intervals, to listen to our fellow orchestra members as we play together, and to distinguish our sounds as individual players. With a focus on repertoire that is less complex our orchestras have had the opportunity to grow together. By training our ears, listening to ourselves and each other we are able to create a more cohesive and symbiotic sound.

We are settling in to the 2-block model of programming which has permitted students more time with their sectional teachers, as well as time playing together as an orchestra. This 2-block model has allowed us to emphasize mentorship within our orchestras; mentorship is a key pillar of the Sistema model, activated in Sistema programs all across the globe. Our two new orchestras, the Carreño and Berlioz groups, held their premiere performances together at our Friends and Families Night on January 23. They played beautifully together. Another highlight was a duet performance of J.S. Bach's Minuet in G Major, given by Agampar (trombone) and Mr. Vishnevsky (pocket trumpet). It was truly lovely.





Sistema Elwick represented Sistema Winnipeg, by facilitating a String Instrument Petting Zoo preceding the Winnipeg Symphony Orchestra's kids concert: How the Gimquat Found her Song. Children from across the city lined up and got to try out a violin, viola, cello, and bass. Thank you so much to those who participated, you did a fantastic job!

Selected senior members of our Carreño orchestra performed at a retirement celebration for Assistant Superintendent and champion of the Sistema program, Lydia Hedrich. We are proud to have been the only group asked to perform at her celebration. Well
