Welcome to Room 3!

Seven Oaks School Division K-8 schools will be collecting monies and have purchased school supplies for the upcoming school year. Riverbend School will be collecting \$40.00 per student. Parents may pay through Parent Connect or bring in cash or a cheque at the orientation meetings in September. It is the intent of our school division to minimize costs for parents and through bulk purchasing we are striving to accomplish this. This is consistent with our policy of keeping school related costs to a minimum for parents; for example, no charge for field trips.

Below is a list of additional items that are needed this year. Please bring in the following items to your <u>orientation meeting</u> in September.

- o indoor runners labelled with your child's name.
- a change of clothes inside a plastic bag that your child can keep inside their locker or backpack (in case there are any accidents/weather related messes)
- backpack labelled with your child's name
- a reusable water bottle labelled with your child's name that your child can bring to and from school every day
- 2 boxes of Kleenex
- A box of bandages <u>or</u> a box of ziplock bags

Students are required to have indoor and outdoor runners.

- They do not need to be expensive
- **No skateboarding shoes** as they are specifically designed for skateboarding and are not suitable for walking, running, jumping, etc.
- Outdoor runners are especially important in the fall and spring when physical education classes and other activities are often held outdoors.

Students in Kindergarten, Grade 1, Grade 2 and Grade 3 are not required to change for Phys. Ed. classes. We recommend that they come to school dressed suitably for physical activity (comfortable bottoms, t-shirts, shorts etc.)

Please put your child's name in all articles of clothing that stays at the school as well as all their outdoor clothing. Especially with things such as ski-pants, boots etc, they will often get mixed up without proper labeling.
