You will be requested to provide two-pieces of ID. When applying for a Criminal Record Search Certificate please request <u>vulnerable sector verification</u>. A Criminal Record Search Certificate without the vulnerable sector screening will <u>not be accepted</u>. Please provide the original document as we take copies and return original to you. Document must be current (within 1 year).
