We are here on Treaty One Land, the traditional home land of the Anishinaabeg, Ininiwak, Anishininiwak, Dakota and Dene peoples, as well the homeland of the Red River Metis Nation. Garden City Collegiate is located on the Red River floodplain, an important part of the Lake Winnipeg watershed. Our province's name - Manitoba - comes from the [Anishinaabemowin](#) word for "Where God sits" and was given to us by Louis Riel, the Founding father of Manitoba. Riel gave up his life in the creation of our province and in the pursuit of a democratic government that we now all benefit from. In our class, some of us come from first, second and third generation immigrant families who came to this land for opportunities and for freedoms. Some of us come from the original peoples of this land. We all have a responsibility to learn about the people who have come before us and to take care of the land that we are on for those who come after us.
