Thank you so much to Baby Iniya and her wonderful family for participating in our Roots of Empathy program in Kindergarten this year!

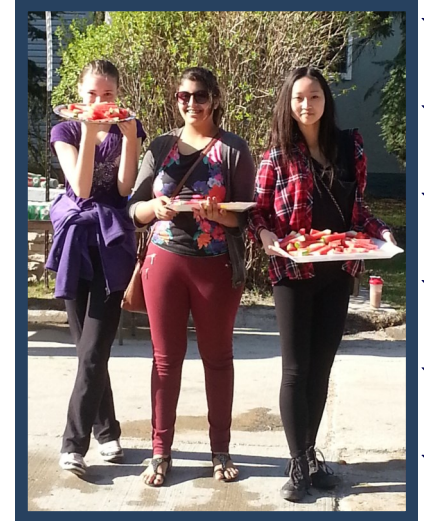
What a beautiful experience it has been watching Iniya grow and having her family become part of the AEW Community!

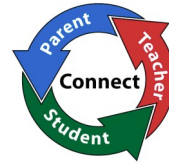


From the Music Room
