

Open during weekdays including evenings and weekends to meet the unexpected healthcare needs of individuals and their family during times when most other clinics are closed.

Clinic Hours:
Monday to Friday: 12PM to 7:30PM
Saturdays and Sundays: 9AM to 4:30PM
Statutory Holidays: 9AM to 4:30PM

It has registered nurses and nurse practitioners who can diagnose and treat minor health issues and can also prescribe medication for the conditions they are assessing.

- Health Issues that can be treated include:**
- ◆ bumps, bruises, or sprains;
 - ◆ rashes, eczema, infected cuts, or minor sores;
 - ◆ sore throat, earache, colds and flu, cough, hay fever, or nose bleeds;
 - ◆ immunizations;
 - ◆ sore eyes with redness or infection;
 - ◆ stomach pain, diarrhea and vomiting, urinary infections, or indigestion;
 - ◆ headache, back pain, or neck pain;
 - ◆ birth control or breast feeding issues; and
 - ◆ stress or anxiety.
