A MET SCHOOL INTERNSHIP INITIATIVE



Theatre Hub was founded to create a shared creative space for Met students across Seven Oaks who wanted to collaborate beyond their individual schools. Student founders **Marley Passante, Ehrian Lane Federis, Tatiana Tuazon, and Jaxon German**, students from all three Met schools, began the Hub after conversations with advisors Emma and Terri about working with theatre students from other Met programs. Their goal was to simulate a real-world theatre company, where students take ownership of creative decisions, production roles, and collaboration, while still receiving guidance and support from advisors and mentors. Fully student-led, the Theatre Hub has been shaped and sustained with long-term mentorship from **Aaron Frost, Stephen Sim, and Toby Hughes**, who have supported the group's growth and vision. Founded in 2024, the Theatre Hub is still young, but its roots are strong. Its first meeting brought students together to finalize plans for the musical CLUE, setting the tone for collaborative, student-driven theatre work across the Met community.
