Dear Victory Families,

On February 28th we started registering children for Kindergarten for the 2022/2023 school year. If your child was born in 2017, you can register online by visiting the Seven Oaks School Division website or you can call our school office and arrange an appointment time to complete registration in-person.

A reminder to please abide by the road signs while dropping off your child at school. At the front of the school there is a "Stop, Drop and Go" area for families, and we have many side streets available for families to park and walk their children to the building or pick them up at the end of the day. Our school parking lot is not a safe option and is reserved for staff of the school, the Board Office and the Public Library. Our school bus loop must remain clear for school buses and for our divisional maintenance personnel. Thank you for your consideration.

In February we celebrated I Love to Read month. We posted photos on our school Twitter and Instagram accounts so that families could take part in the fun.

A few highlights include:

- daily 'mystery readers' reading parts of a story over the school intercom
- virtual guest readers for individual classrooms
- a weeklong celebration of the life and works of author Joe McLellan
- a library club run by our school Librarian, Mr. Jesse
- stories read in many languages by our school staff
- stories shared around an outdoor bonfire

Our school musical production of "Stone Soup" was recorded earlier this month and we look forward to sharing the performance (virtually) with our families in the days to come.

Teacher/Parent/Student conferences will take place through virtual conferences, phone calls, or in-person meetings on Thursday, March 17th in the evening and during the day of Friday, March 18th. Families will use Parent Connect to book their conference appointment time. Parents and caregivers will be able to view report cards online and book conference times starting on Tuesday, March 15th at 10:00 a.m. Please contact our school office if you have any difficulties using Parent Connect. Your child must be born in 2017***

Completed registration form (available after February 28) must include:

2 copies—Proof of address document

Acceptable documents: Utility bills, lease or home purchase documents, Tax assessment documents. Manitoba Health cards will not be accepted.

1 copy—Proof of birthdate document

Acceptable documents: Birth certificate, baptismal certificate or passport.

When registering on-line, it will be helpful to have ready copies/photos of these required documents on the device or computer you will be using at the time of registration. During registration, there will be sections for you to upload the documents into your registration form.

Please note: we will be following up within 2 – 3 business days of receiving your online registration to verify your information and to complete the registration process.

Victory School has both morning and afternoon sessions.

The morning class is from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 a.m.

The afternoon class is from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m.

Mexico is hot. (Joa)

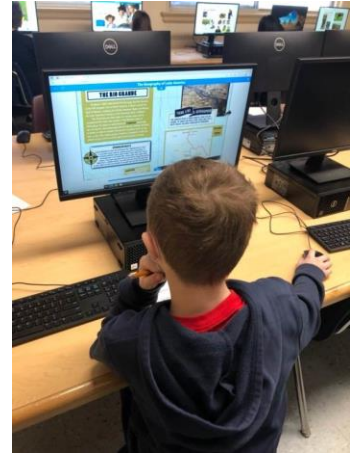
Samosa's are one of the traditional foods in India. (Lawrence)

In 2009, France produced more than 6.4 billion bottles of wine. French and English are the two most common spoken languages in France. (Porter)

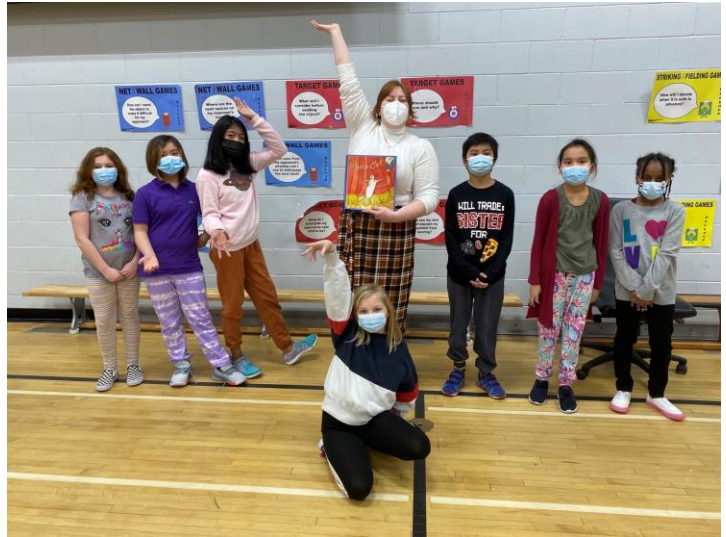

Victory Viper Physical Education

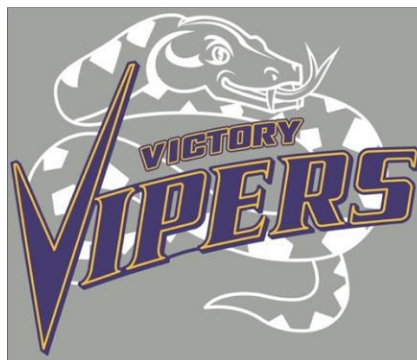
