
Register ONLINE Now!

Children born in 2020 can start Kindergarten in September 2025. You must register at your catchment school for Kindergarten. If you are unsure what your catchment school is, feel free to call our office at 204-694-8688. When registering, you will need to attach your child's birth certificate or passport, as well as proof of current address (2 pieces i.e. offer to purchase, lease agreement, property tax bill, hydro bill, water bill, etc.), plus any other important documents (PR card, work permit/study permit, custody arrangements etc).

CULTURE CLUB AT THE AKI CENTRE




In February, Finney's Indigenous Students Culture Club had its very first outing as a group to Ozhaawashkwaa Animikii-Bineshi Aki Onji Kinimaagae' Inun, commonly known as the "Aki Centre"! The Aki Centre is a year-round gathering space rooted in Indigenous ways of knowing for Seven Oaks learners, educators, and the extended community.

We were welcomed to the land and offered to smudge with Elder Lorie Thompson. Elder Lorie led us through Medicine Wheel teachings about the stages of life. While our oldest students started fires to roast bannock, the youngest students listened to books and created bracelets with the colours of the Medicine Wheel. Our afternoon was filled with sledding, exploring the greenhouse, outdoor Indigenous games, and a reflection circle.

Finney now has over 35 students involved in Culture Club from Kindergarten to Grade 5. We look forward to seeing the club grow and future outings in the coming years!

Missing a day of school here and there may not seem like much, but absences add up!

IF YOUR CHILD MISSES 2 DAYS A MONTH

- They will MISS 15 DAYS of school a year.

- They will MISS 1 YEAR of school by the end of Grade 12.

IF YOUR CHILD MISSES 4 DAYS A MONTH

They will MISS 30 DAYS of school a year.

(This is MORE THAN ONE MONTH of school)

They will MISS 2 YEARS of school by the end of Grade 12.

IF YOUR CHILD IS <u>10 MINUTES</u> LATE FOR CLASS EVERY DAY

- They will miss 33 HOURS of instruction over the school year.
