- Outside of the time directly before and after school when busses are running, you may use the bus loop to park for short periods of time, but engines must be turned off as there is fresh air intake along that wall and we can't have exhaust fumes entering the classrooms. Watapîwat: woven basket (Ukrainian easter) (Cree)
