


École Constable Edward Finney School May 2025 Newsletter

ONLINE Kindergarten and New Student Registration

Kindergarten and New Student registration has begun! Please visit <u>www.70aks.org</u> and click on the "Registration" button.



Children born in **2020** can start Kindergarten in September 2025.

You must register at your catchment school for Kindergarten. If you are unsure what your catchment school is, feel free to call our office at 204-694-8688.

When registering, you will need to attach your child's birth certificate or passport, as well as proof of current address (2 pieces i.e. offer to purchase, lease agreement, property tax bill, hydro bill, water bill, etc.), plus any other important documents (PR card, work permit/study permit, custody arrangements etc).


