


Conflict at school...

Conflict at school among peers is a normal, developmental part of growing up. It is our job, as adults in their lives, to support positive, healthy problem solving skills. Different children need different amounts of support in this. Sometimes, when children feel overwhelmed with the conflict, adults step in to assist.

Most of the time children can resolve conflict in positive, healthy ways when given the time and support that they need. At school, healthy relationships with people in our lives is taught regularly throughout the curriculum.

If your child is experiencing conflict here at school and you feel like they need additional support in resolving things with peers, please reach out to your child's classroom teacher.



Do NOT stop or park in the crosswalk area directly in front of the school. This is illegal and poses serious threat to students trying to cross and vehicles in motion not being able to see them crossing.

We have a stop, drop and go zone for families directly in front of the school heading NORTH, the same direction that buses are travelling.

We cherish our positive relationships with neighbours and ask that everyone respect driveways as our neighbours have the right to move in and out of their property at any time. Please do not block their driveways for any length of time.

The bus loop is accessible in the morning until 8:20am and after school before 3:10pm. Once busses come and go, the bus loop is inaccessible. A reminder that engines MUST BE OFF in the bus loop as the school's fresh air intake is all along the front wall of the school. PLEASE DO NOT REVERSE OUT OF THE BUS LOOP. This puts students who are crossing in danger.

<u>A reminder that there is NO PARKING in the staff parking lot at any time.</u> There is ample parking on all surrounding streets with walkways to the school and the school grounds.
