It is getting cooler out; please remember to dress for the weather—mitts, toque, neck warmer, warm coat, rubber boots, etc...




The parking lot spots are all paid spots for staff and we ask that parents do not use the lot for pick up and drop off of students at any time of the day. We've witnessed this become very unsafe for your children and we kindly ask that you refrain from entering the lot.

Do **NOT stop or park in the crosswalk** area directly in front of the school. This is illegal and poses serious threat to students trying to cross and vehicles in motion not being able to see them crossing.

We have a stop, drop and go zone for families directly in front of the school heading NORTH, the same direction that buses are travelling.

We cherish our positive relationships with neighbours and ask that everyone respect driveways as our neighbours have the right to move in and out of their property at any time. Please do not block their driveways for any length of time.



The bus loop is accessible in the morning until 8:20am and after school before 3:10pm. Once busses come and go, the bus loop is inaccessible. A reminder that engines **MUST BE OFF** in the bus loop as the school's fresh air intake is all along the front wall of the school.

There is ample parking on all surrounding streets with walkways to the school and the school grounds.


