#### What is the Treaty Acknowledgement and why do we say it?

There is not just one Treaty Acknowledgement, there are different acknowledgements for the many different treaty lands across Canada and the wording may vary from one occasion to another. Школа R. F. Morrison School is on Treaty 1 land. We read the following acknowledgement before O Canada each morning:

"We would like to acknowledge and honor that we are on the traditional homeland of the Anishinaabe, Inninew, Cree, Dakota, Dene and Metis people as well as Treaty One Territory. Remember, we are all treaty people."

You might hear similar acknowledgements in Universities, political addresses, sporting events and any other gathering of national significance. This is one important way of showing recognition of Canada's indigenous peoples of past and present as addressed in the *Truth and Reconciliation Commission of Canada: Calls to Action* (45, i-iv).
