#### Call to Order and Greetings:

#### Administrative Report:

- David checked with the division about the purchase of a Square for fundraising use. We are allowed to buy and use a Square.
- Population is down to 533 students, but there are some new registrations.
- There was a final walk through with the building constructions.
  - There have been some problems with the sky lights. They are trying to fix that.
  - There have also been some problems with the dimmer lights that they are working to fix.
- Tech Hub has started a program at the school for a group of Grade 5 8 students to learn coding. It's going very well.
- The school is doing the Jack Frost Challenge this week. Each class going outside at least once a day.
- The jerseys that we bought are now in. They are reversible and look great.
- The Kindergarten Open House will be Wednesday, May 10<sup>th</sup>. The PAC meeting will have to be on the Tuesday of that week.
- On Friday, February 3<sup>rd</sup>, the staff had a PD session on Jump Math program.
  The staff will consider bringing this program into the school to be used.
- David gave us information regarding the highway expansion program.
  - There will be two entrances: one on Hiawatha, then 20 yards further north of Minnehaha. There will be a turning lane.
  - Cars and buses will come in through the north entrance, and exit in the south.
  - Lights at Minnehaha will be moved north as well

- The walking path is gone right now and has not been replaced. We need a path from the school to the curling club, as that is the emergency centre
  - We need to have a path back on both sides of the highway for the benefit and safety of our students.
  - We, as a PAC, can write a letter to the municipality to help this cause.
- The project should be starting in the summer of 2024, and will take two years, at least.

# Hot Lunch:

- Subway is too expensive.
- The committee looked at McDonald's and Costco for other options.
- McDonald's:
  - $\circ$  will provide 10% off the entire order.
  - $\circ$  can deliver
  - we won't do Happy Meals (not fair to other kids)
- Costco can make hotdogs for us
  - committee will pick up and bring to the school
  - they will also purchase large ketchup and mustards at Costco and buy smaller containers for the classrooms

- will need to look into gluten-free buns; and allergy concerns (ie. sesame)
- Aim to start for March 1<sup>st</sup>
- Kenisha will put together an order form to get out to the school
- We will do a hot lunch, alternating with the pizza lunches.
  - Hot dogs will be once a month, and McDonald's will be once a month.
- Cost \$2 per hot dog; \$3.50 for a McDonald's burger
- we will also purchase extras for families, at admin's discretion
- Kenisha also presented on Munch-a-Lunch. This is an online ordering system. We can get a 2-month free trial, and then \$300 per school year. David says that this would have to go through the division.
