Call to Order and Greetings:

Administrative Report:

- Current enrollment: 605 students
- There are 41 students registered for Kindergarten. In 2023 at this time, there were about 50, so the numbers are expected.
- There are lots of puddles outside! It's better for students to wear the proper clothing and bring dry clothes to change into, as opposed to try to keep them out of the puddles!
- Phys Ed is hoping to get a new projector to use as a scoreboard.
 - The old projector needs a new bulb which is expensive and costs to get someone to replace. This fix could be \$1000 or so.
 - A new laser projector which is better and bigger, is in the range of 5-6 thousand dollars. David is getting some quotes. We also need a better idea of other costs that may go with it (ie. software)
 - A new projector would allow for projections on the west side of the gym.
 - PAC could use it as well; hold movie nights, etc.
- Upcoming pizza days = April 17, May 1, May 15, May 29
- May 29 31 Arts in the Park which will be held behind the Maples Community Centre and Arena
- Day of Dance is on Thursday, April 11, with a r rehearsal on Monday, April 1st

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- There is a survey happening with all students in Grades 4 8 called "Our School" and allows students to express how they are feeling about their time in school
- Registration for students who live out of catchment/ division -
 - this will not be a sustainable model
 - we can't continue to take everyone and while there are certain exceptions, most of the time, students will be moved from WSP School to the school closer to their home
 - catchment areas changed about 3 years ago and may change again as development continued
 - the school is already very tight for space, as we know.
