Re: Manitoba Public Health Travel and Self-Isolation Requirements


Please be aware of the following Manitoba Public Health guidance if your family is travelling out of province or out of Canada.

Considering travelling during the winter break? If so, know the requirements for travellers upon return to Manitoba.

- If your travel is **within Canada** be aware of the [Travel and Self-isolation Requirements](#) for all individuals returning to Manitoba. For further information, see [Self-isolation \(Quarantine\) for Asymptomatic Returning Travellers](#) and [Testing for Travellers](#).
 - For domestic travellers, if you are fully immunized and two weeks have passed since your last dose at the time of your arrival, you are exempt from needing to self-isolate (quarantine) under the provincial travel order. Domestic travel exemptions include children under the age of 12, if all individuals they travelled with are fully immunized.
- If your travel is **outside of Canada** then the [Government of Canada guidance](#) applies. International travelers MUST follow federal self-isolation (quarantine) [requirements](#).
 - Note that [unvaccinated children under 12 without symptoms and traveling with fully vaccinated parents or guardians](#) cannot attend school, camp or daycare (among other activities) for 14 days upon return to Canada.
