



Where to find the Self-Serve Password Portal

Access to the portal to change your password is right on the Seven Oaks website under utility links, the orange arrow below.




Changing Your Password on the Self-Serve Password Portal

Once you are registered you can change your password here at <https://aka.ms/sspr> enter your username and info below. **Please use your Seven Oaks email account to log on.**



Enter the phone number which you used when you registered for access. Click on text or call me to verify it is you.



Enter your verification number that you receive on your phone, enter and click on next.
