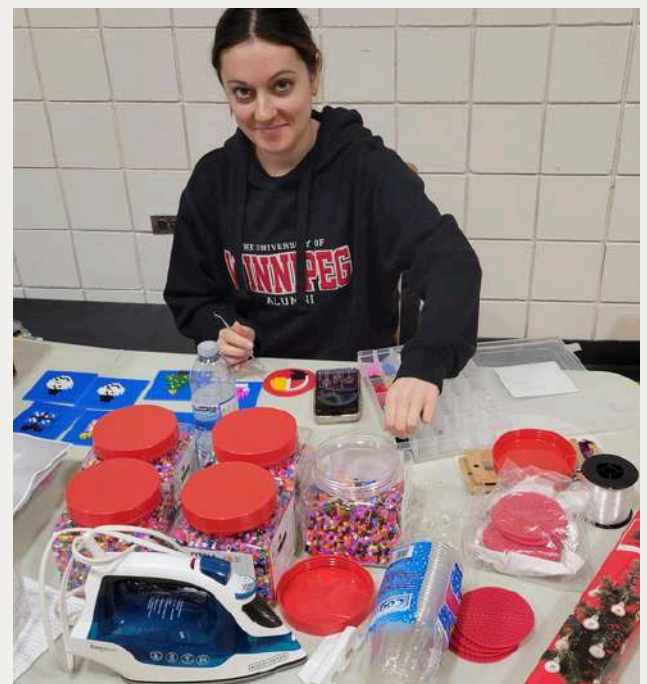

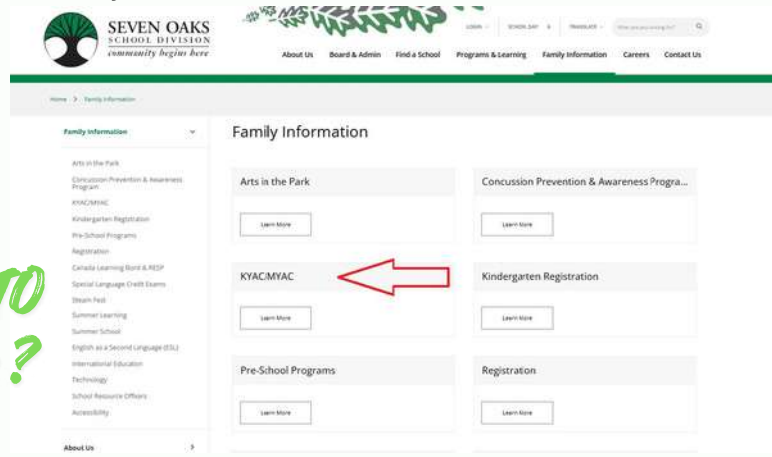

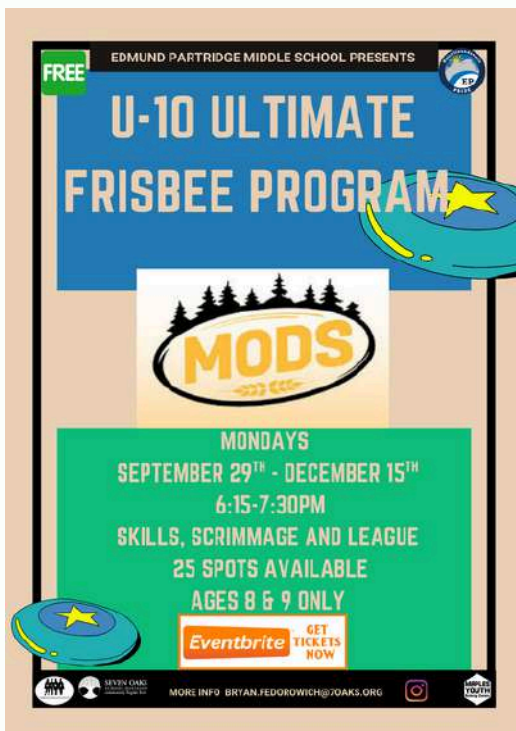


How to Register
