




WE KICKED OFF OUR BALANCED SCHOOL

SCHOOL PATROL SAFETY TIPS

- At any intersection with a School Safety Patrol, please make sure to stop behind the patrol and wait for their instructions.
- ALWAYS LOOK BOTH WAYS WHEN CROSSING
 THE STREET AND MAKE SURE CARS HAVE COME TO
 A COMPLETE STOP BEFORE CROSSING.
- Make sure to walk when crossing the street, also, if you are on a bike, make sure to get off your bike and walk it across with you!
- When crossing from a bus to the side of the street, wait for patrol instructions and look to the bus driver to wave you across...
- When riding a bus, make sure to listen to the bus patrols and the bus driver!
