TRC week – Did you know that the Truth and Reconciliation Commission was created to inform all Canadians about what happened in Residential Schools? They worked to listen and document the stories of residential school survivors and their families. Then, they created 94 Calls to Action or recommendations for the government to work toward reconciliation. Call to Action number 62 calls on the government to give teachers the tools needed so that every student in Canada can learn about residential schools, Indigenous culture and people.
