## Service Link **Manitoba**

- Service Link is a **Manitoba Government tool** which will help you find out if you qualify for any of the services or programs listed below.
- The questionnaire is on-line.
- There are a number of questions you need to answer: The first 2 questions are about where you live in Manitoba. The next 6 pages are questions about you, your financial situation, who you live with, where you live etc....
- At the end, Service Link will suggest services you are able apply for or receive. This can be very helpful because sometimes you don't know about services which are available to you.
