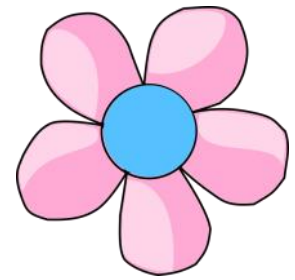
Kristina Ansari - (Grade 1/2) Rm 6 - Tamarack
