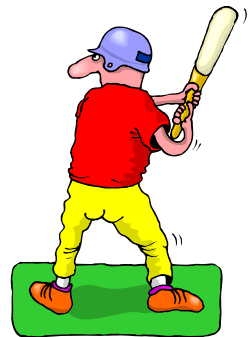


Marathon Club Eight dedicated students and three staff are training to prepare for the Manitoba Marathon. They run two days a week and strength train a third day.
